NOTICE OF RACE

1 RULES

1.1 The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in *The Racing Rules of Sailing*, the rules of the RS 200 Class Association and the rules and byelaws of Papercourt Sailing Club.

2 ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

2.1 The regatta is open to all boats of the RS 200 class.

3 FEES

3.1 The race entry fee will be £15 which includes lunch, afternoon tea and hot drinks.

4 SCHEDULE

- 4.1 The regatta will consist of a maximum of 4 races.
- 4.2 The schedule will be as follows:
 - Registration from 9:30am
 - Briefing: 10:30am
 - First Warning signal: not before 11am
 - 2 races back-to-back before lunch and 2 races back-to-back after lunch.

7 SCORING

- 7.1 The low point scoring system of RRS Appendix A will apply.
- 7.2 One race is required to be completed to constitute a series.
- 7.3 (a) When two or fewer races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores.
 - (b) When three or more races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores excluding her worst score.

8 DISCLAIMER OF LIABILITY

Competitors participate in the regatta entirely at their own risk. See rule 4, Decision to Race. The organizing authority will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during, or after the regatta.

9 INSURANCE

Each participating boat shall be insured with valid third-party liability insurance with a minimum cover of £2,000,000 per event.
